## **The Brock Family Scholarship**

Criteria

1. The scholarship/gifts will be made available to students who have been accepted for admission or are currently enrolled in a 2-4 year college or university. Graduate, vocational, and technical schools will be considered on an individual basis. Preference will be given to financially needy students who are pursuing a bachelor's degree from an accredited 4-year college. Students may apply as early as their junior year of high school. Early application is encouraged but not necessary.

All materials due before May 1<sup>st</sup>, of the year preceeding award.

- 2. Students will need to apply each year for the scholarship. The goal will be to provide scholarships for as many students as possible. Available funds and the number of applicants will dictate the amount of individual award(s). This will be no less than \$200, but no more than \$500 (at this time).
- **3.** Preference in the selection process will be given to students who are descendants of George Anderson and Malissa Wall Brock.
- **4**. The student(s) awarded the Brock Family Scholarship will have to demonstrate successful academic performance and financial need.

Instructions

- 1. Students will need to write one short essay. The essay (at least 100 words) needs to be focused on a subject directly pertaining to the Brock family. Examples: "Family to me is...", "The life of my grandmother...", "The Brock family during WWII...", "From my grandfather's memory George A. Brock was...". This essay should contain either important lessons or historical facts that may later be distributed to the Brock family. Essays will need to be submitted on paper and/or on formatted 3.5" 1.44 MB floppy disk.
- **2.** The enclosed application and financial information form will need to be completed. All family financial information will be kept confidential, and will be used only by the committee to categorize the student's financial need status.
